The church register states the Polly was born 8 July 1776 while the manuscript states that Mary was born 13 April 1774. The age on the grave stone of Mary Messenger confirms a date of birth of 8 July 1776. The manuscript states that Elizabeth was born in 1777 while the church register states that she was born 4 May and baptised 8 June 1778, daughter of Lodewig and Polly Fisher. The marriages of Peter, David, and Ann are not mentioned in the Fisher manuscript.
